CHOCOLATE CHIP DELITE INGREDIENTS:  
 Enriched wheat flour, brown sugar, sugar, semi-sweet chocolate chips (sugar, unsweetened chocolate, cocoa butter, anhydrous dextrose, soya lecithin, vanilla extract), liquid whole egg, soybean and palm oil margarine, unsweetened applesauce, inulin, vanilla extract, baking soda.  
 VANILLA ICE CREAM FILLING INGREDIENTS:  
 Cream, sugar, modified milk ingredients, mono and diglycerides, guar gum, polysorbate 80, carrageenan, dextrose, natural and artificial flavour.
